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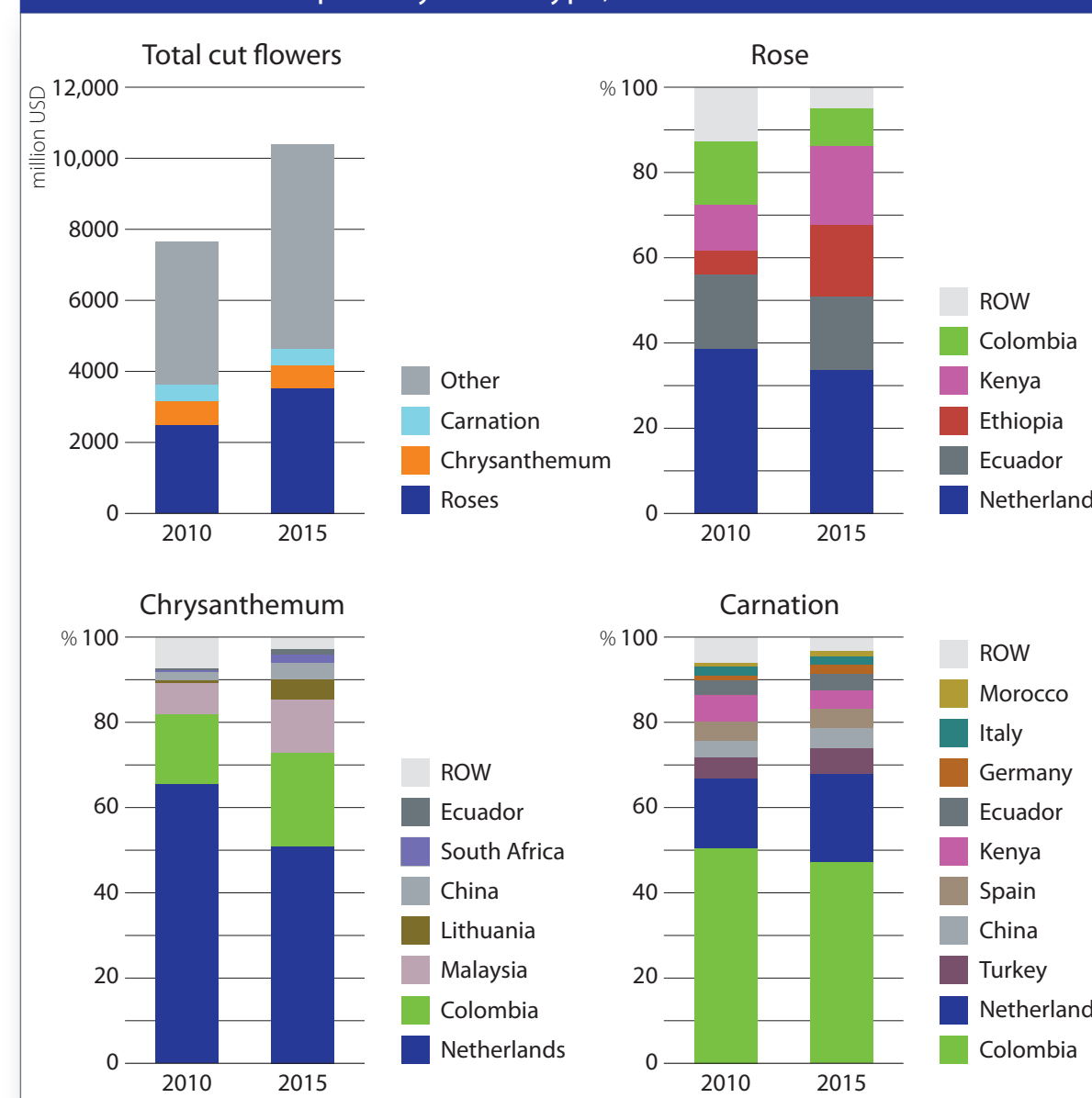

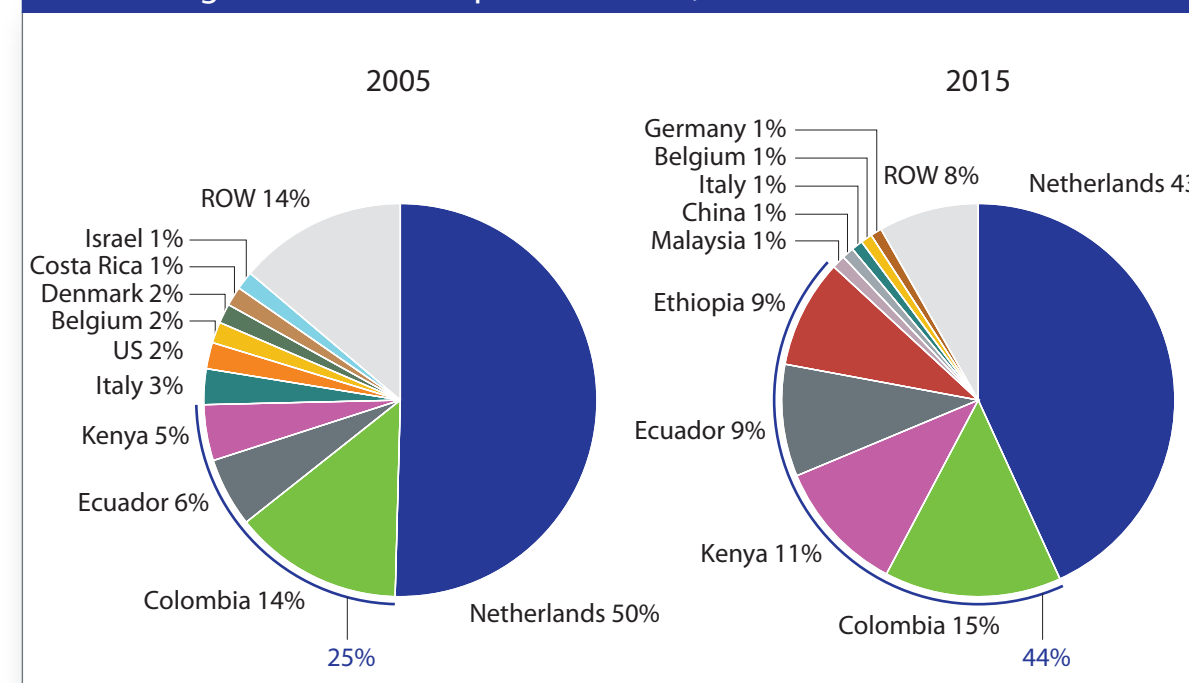
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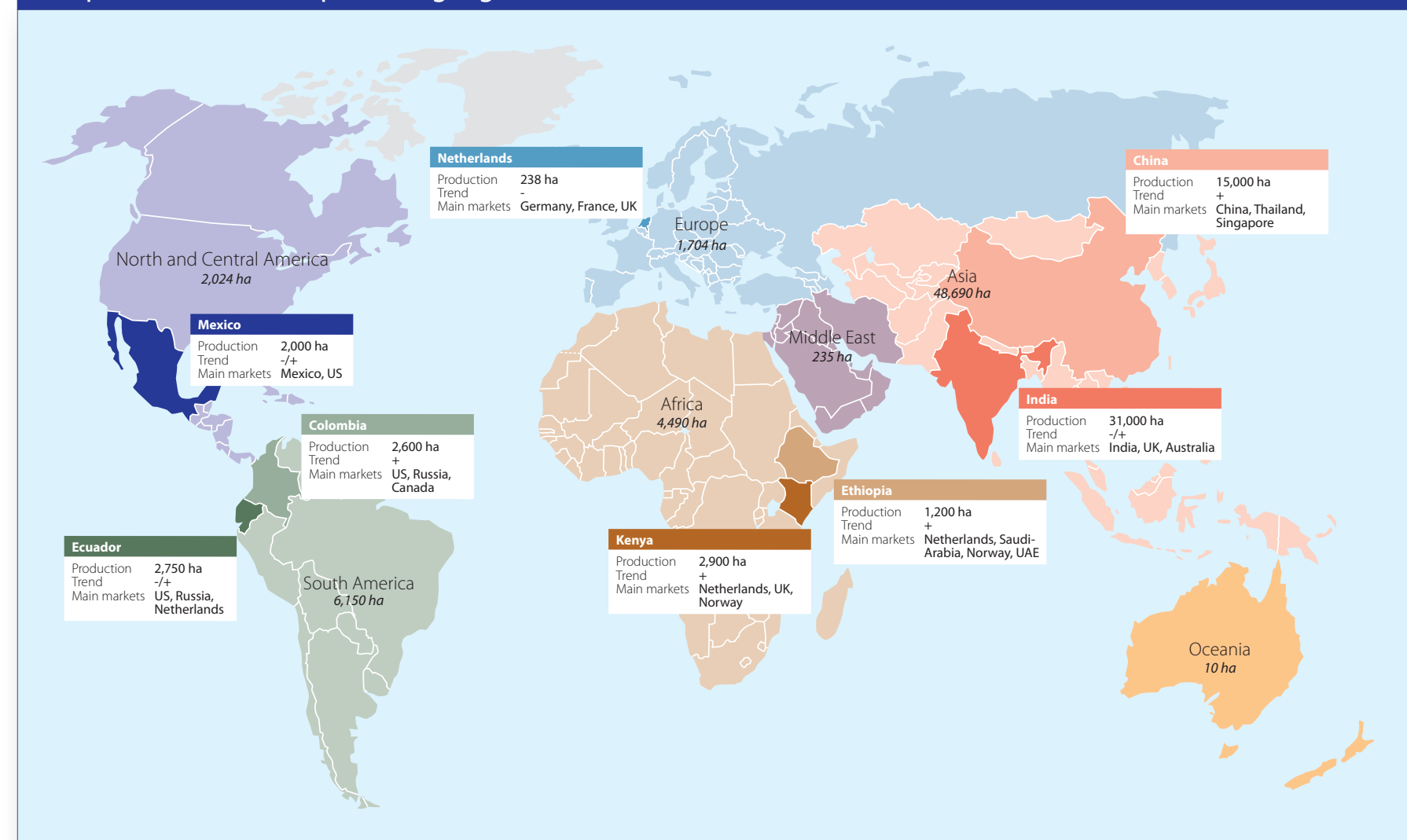
Global cut flower exports by flower type, 2010 vs. 2015



World's largest cut flower export countries, 2005 vs. 2015

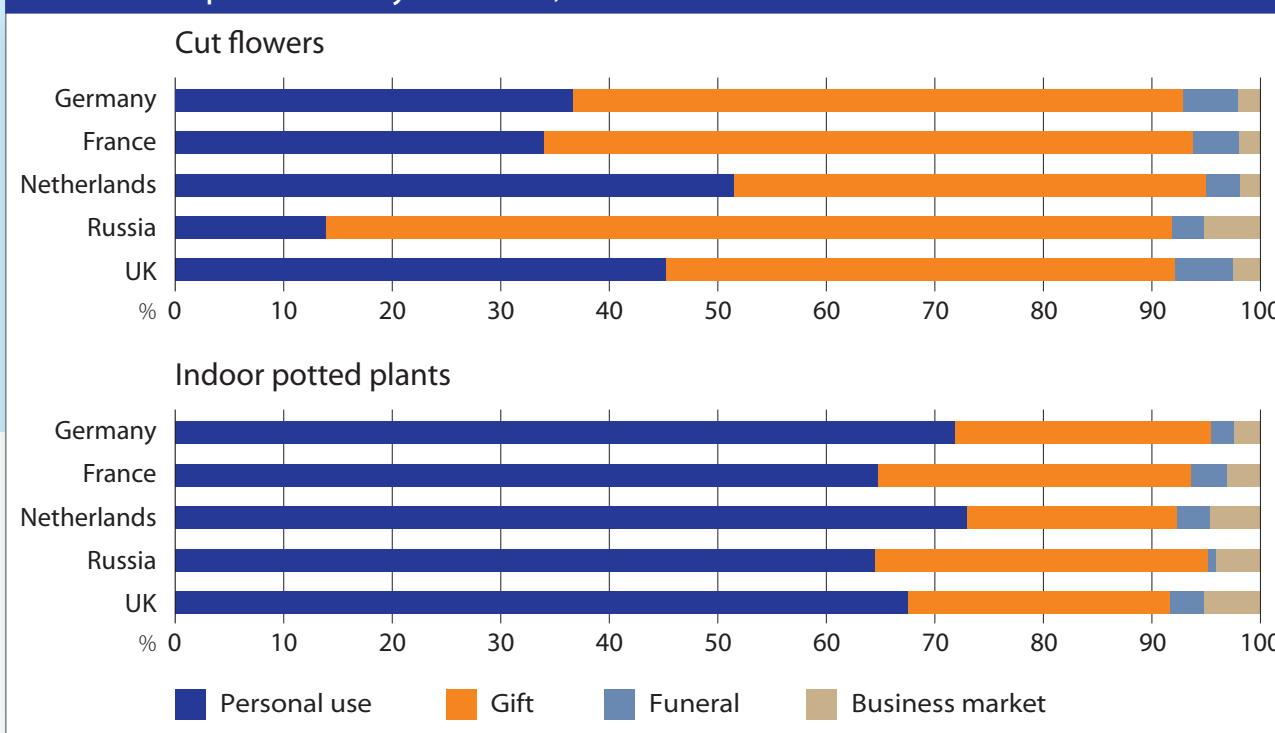


Comparison of cut rose-producing regions and nations



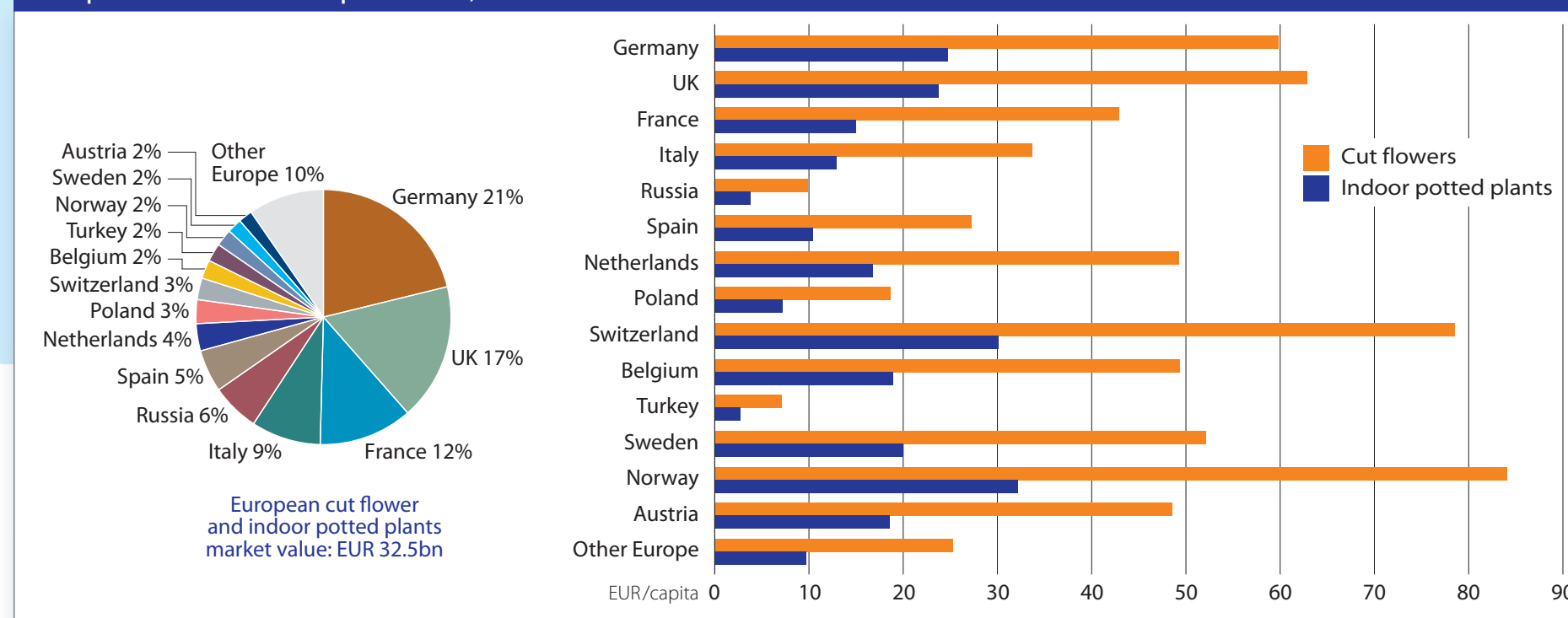
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Floriculture purchases by occasion, 2015

European floriculture expenditure, 2015

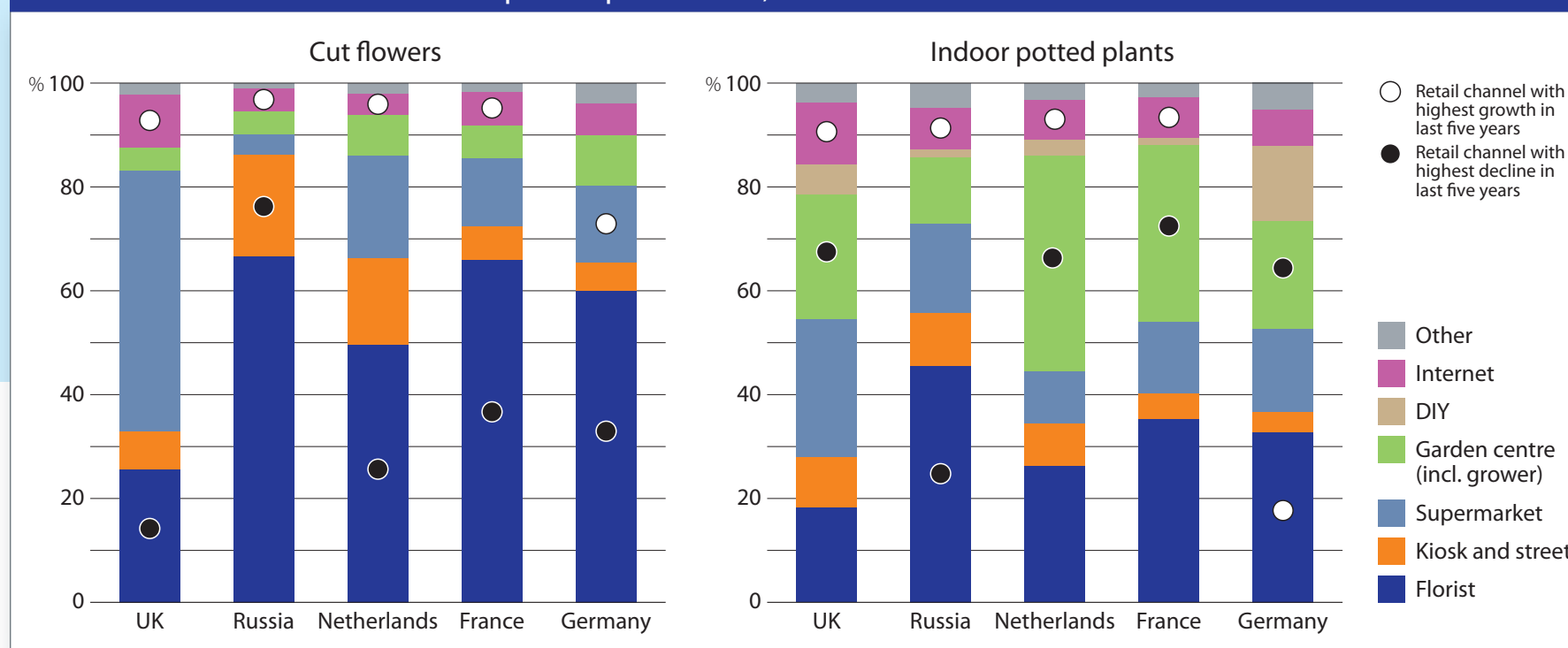

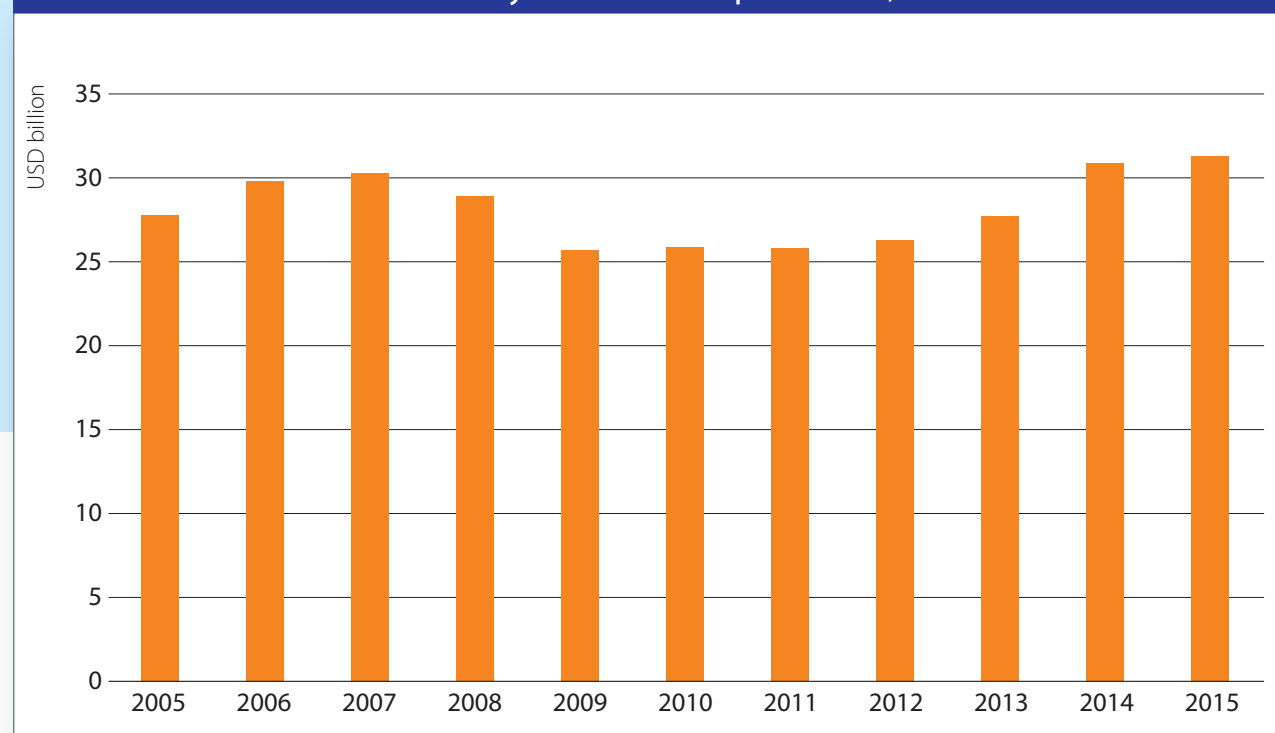
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Retail shares cut flower and indoor potted plants sales, 2015

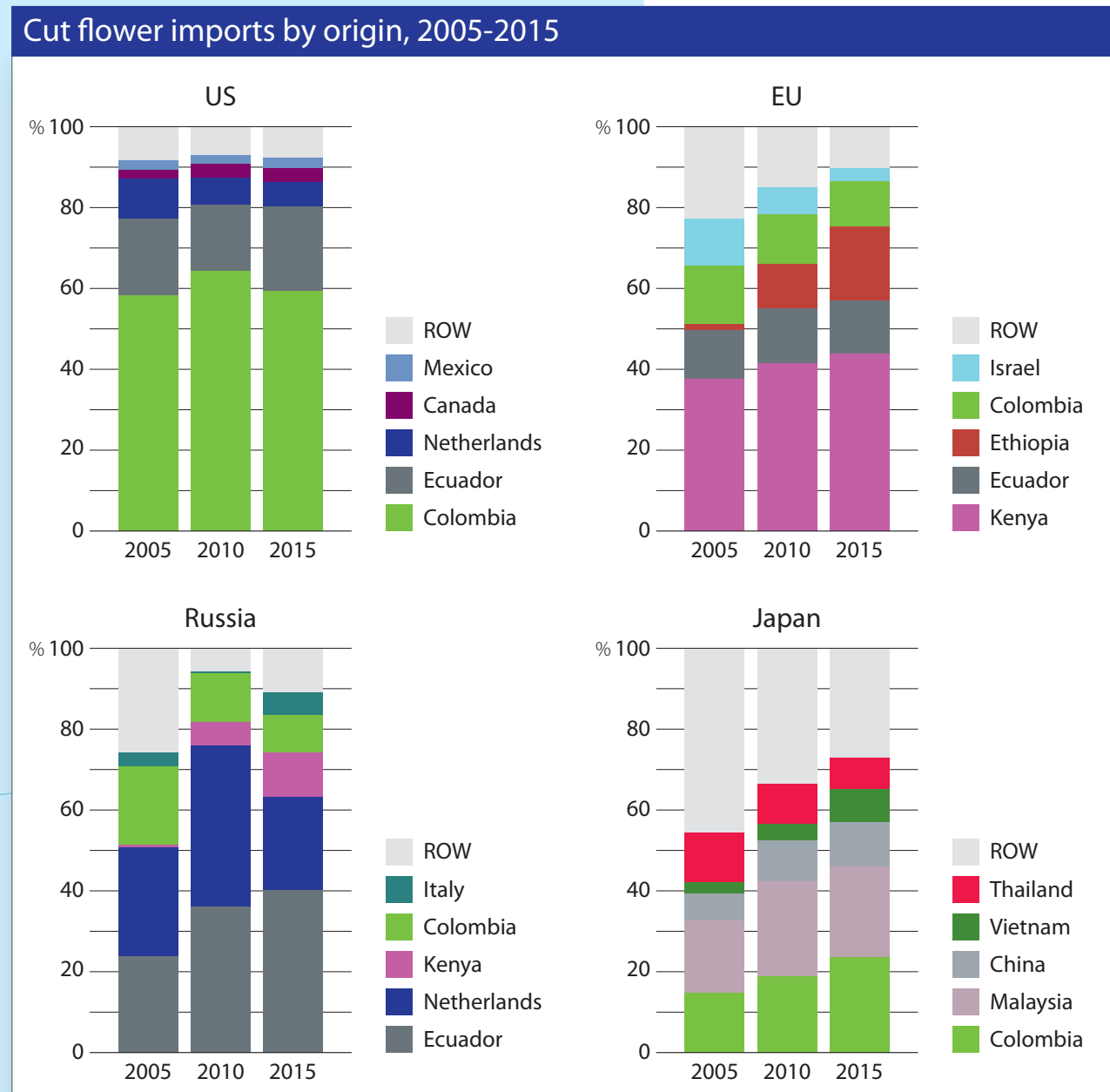
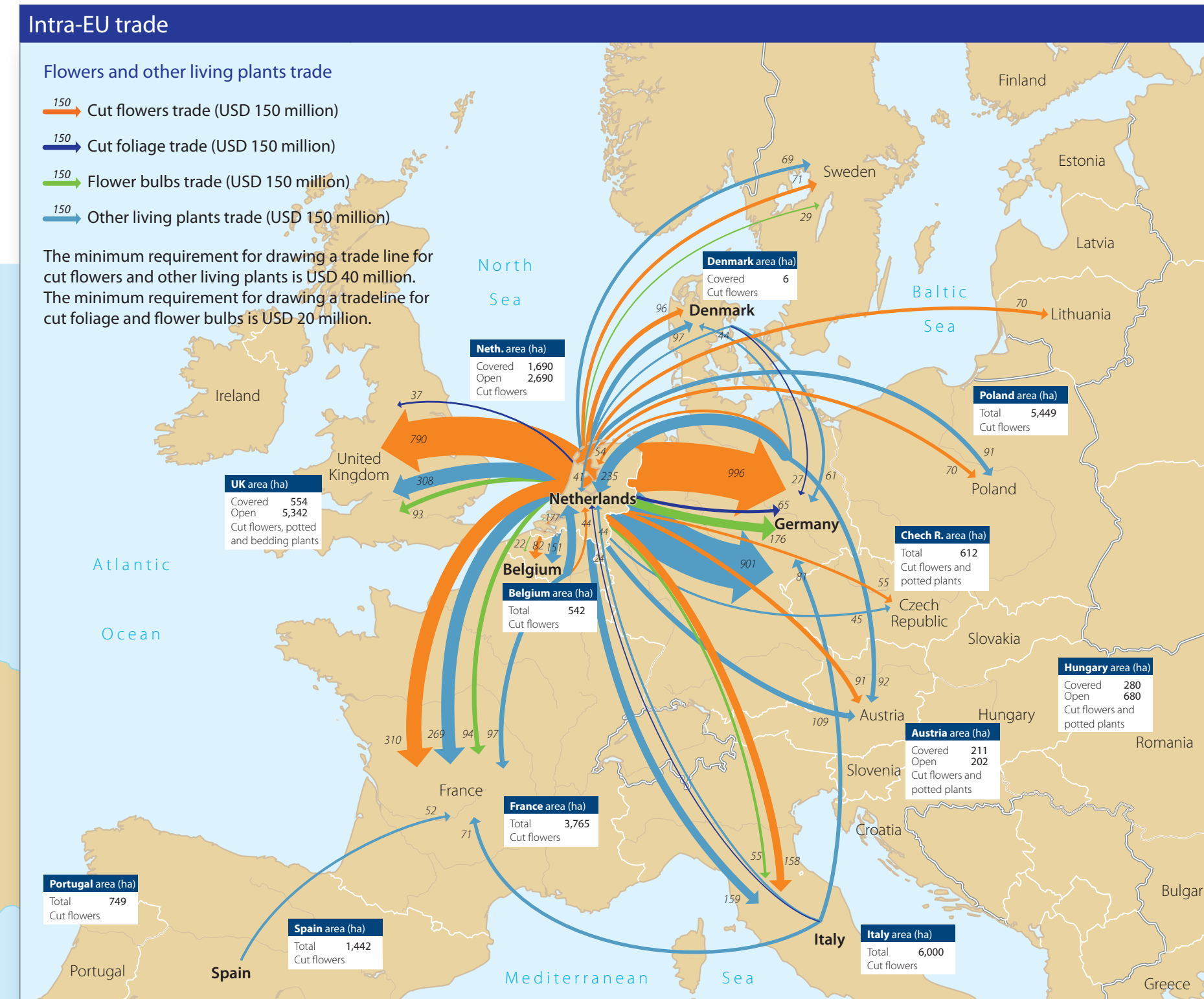
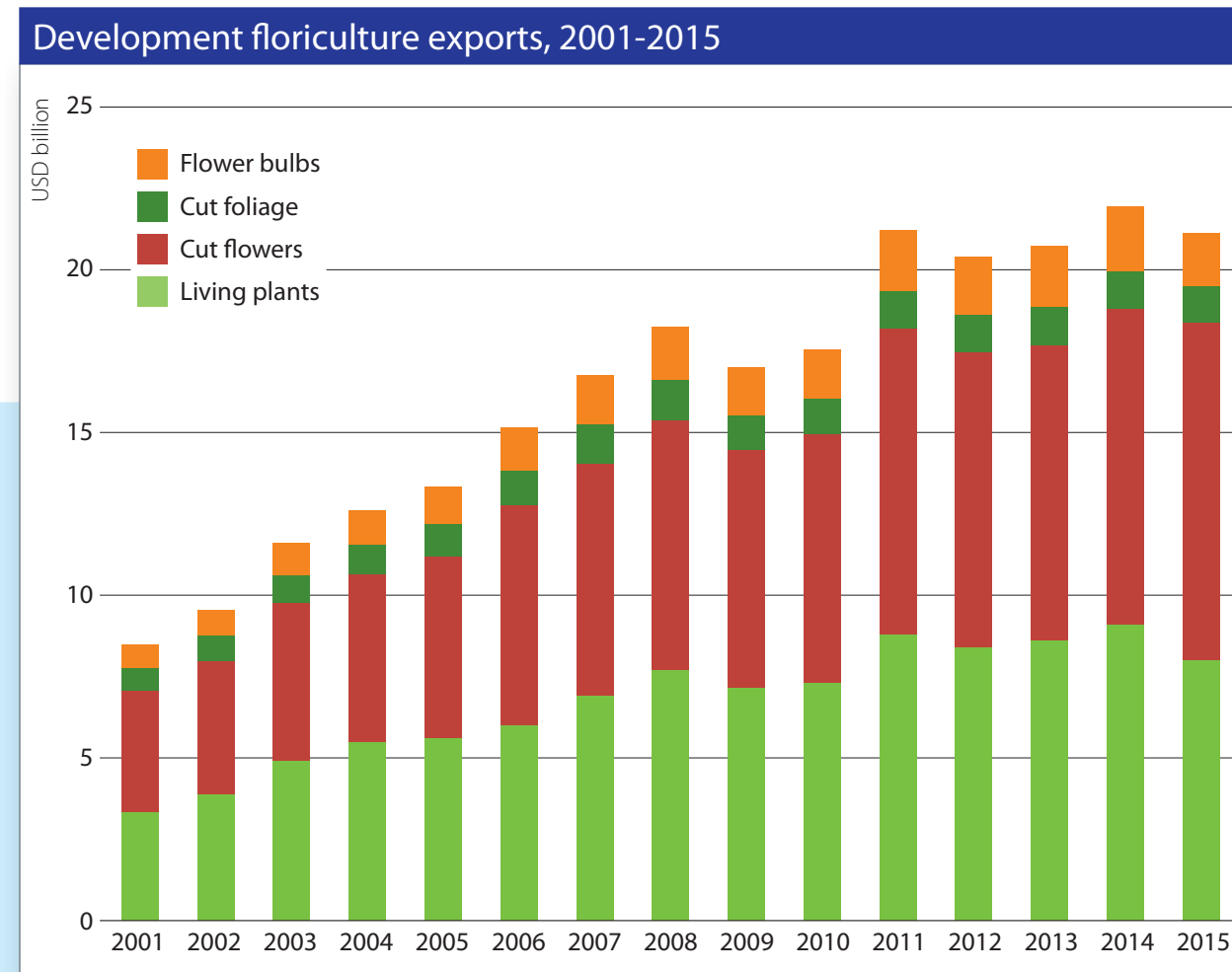
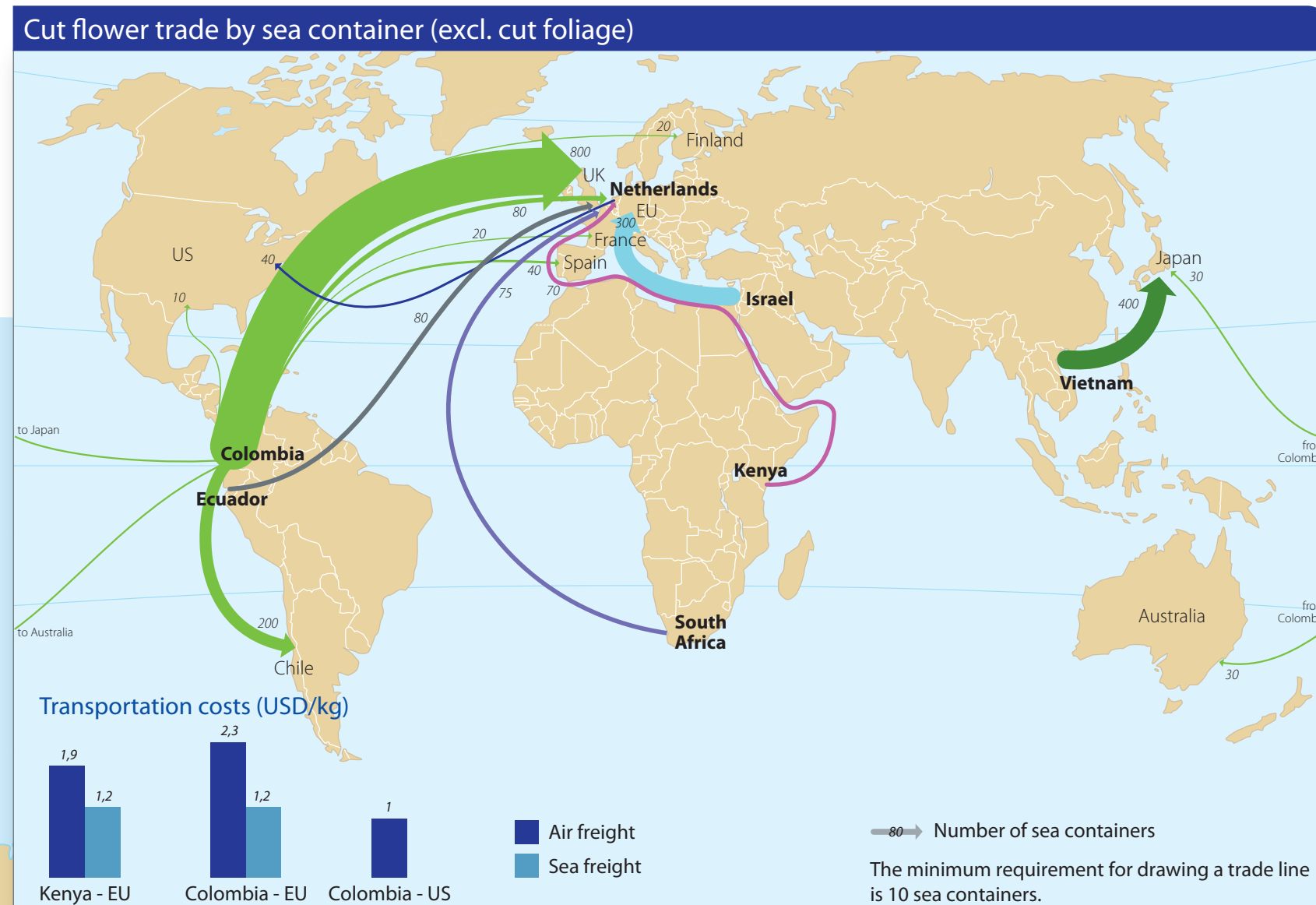


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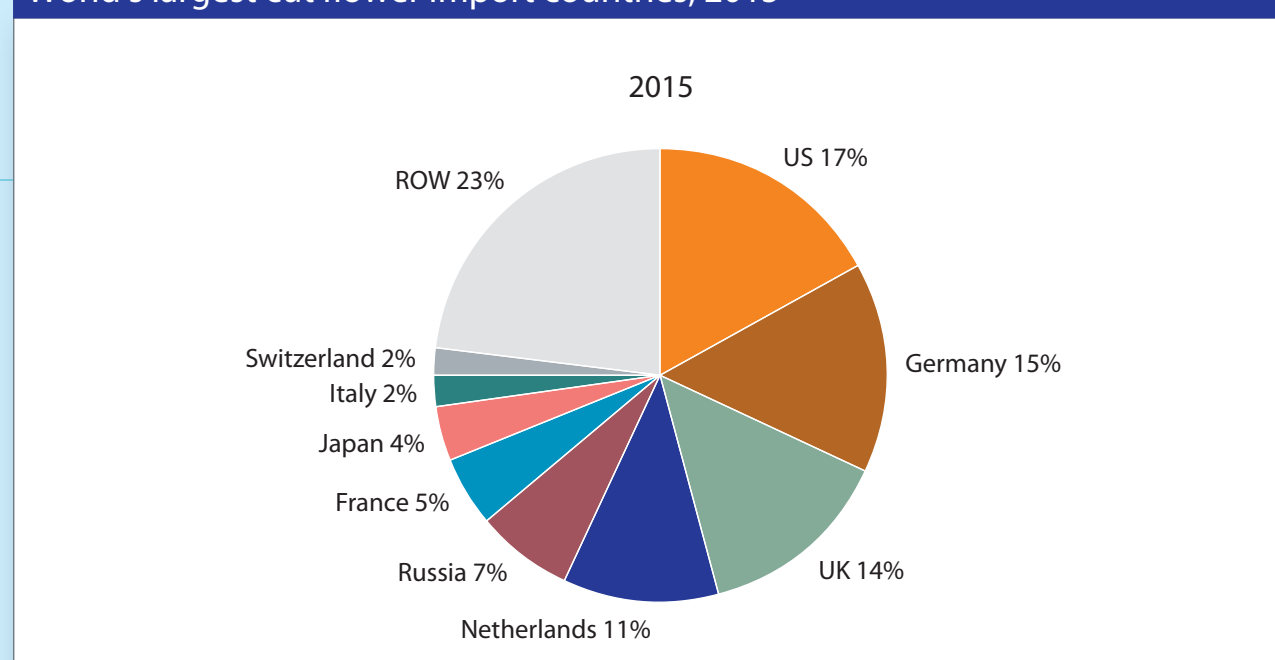
Total US floriculture and nursery consumer expenditure, 2005-2015
